Community Outreach Projects

- **THE COMMUNITY CENTER**

The property and gymnasium located at 1450 Clough Pike is currently being used for community basketball, baseball, soccer and cheerleading teams as well as The Hedge music venue, Wrapping Clermont Together and other various community projects. It's our hope to install a waffle-ball field, volleyball courts and a safe playground for community recreational purposes.

- **WRAPPING CLERMONT TOGETHER**

For over 15 years, Landmark participates and organizes a Christmas drive for those less fortunate in Clermont County. Families participating receive several gifts per child as well as a \$50 food gift card (generally to Kroger) to help them purchase their Christmas dinner. We also offer free family/spiritual counseling as well as free financial counseling with trained and licensed professionals for any family interested. Wrapping Clermont Together has brought together many local schools, organizations and individuals with the common goal of meeting the physical needs of Clermont families while providing opportunities for them to grow beyond their current situations. All participants in the program are cross-checked through the county database at the YWCA in Batavia to help insure we help those truly in need and not those who are abusive to the system.

- **THE HEDGE**

"The Hedge" is an all ages concert venue located at the Landmark Community Center. This is a cooperative effort of ambitious local individuals, ministries and businesses who wish to provide a positive and safe environment for teenagers and young adults in the area. The Hedge creates an atmosphere to build positive relationships, host live music and pursue creative arts all gifts given to us by our infinitely creative God.
